To promote and develop 'in school' competitive events that enable all children to compete in a safe environment	All year groups from Y1 - Y6 have implemented an 'in year' sports competition this year, with some year groups repeating this more than once. The feedback from 100% of staff was positive in the children enjoying and participating in the competition. Other feedback included the positive impact of giving the children the opportunity to take part in competition in a supervised lesson with class teachers, the promotion of socialisation between classes and the use of the new playground markings to support the lesson.
